<p>You must use a very small piece of paper (Represents lack of adequate resources)</p>	<p>You must use a pencil with a broken tip (Represents faulty or inadequate tools)</p>	<p>You have to write on your lap, not a table (Represents lack of proper workspace)</p>
<p>You must write with your non-dominant hand (Represents being forced to work outside your strengths)</p>	<p>You cannot bend your elbow or wrist (Represents physical disability without accommodation)</p>	<p>You must hold the pencil between two fingers only (Represents fine motor skill impairment)</p>
<p>You must be blindfolded (Represents lack of visual access or denied information)</p>	<p>Someone else moves your paper every 10 seconds (Represents instability or disruption beyond your control)</p>	<p>(create your own)</p>
